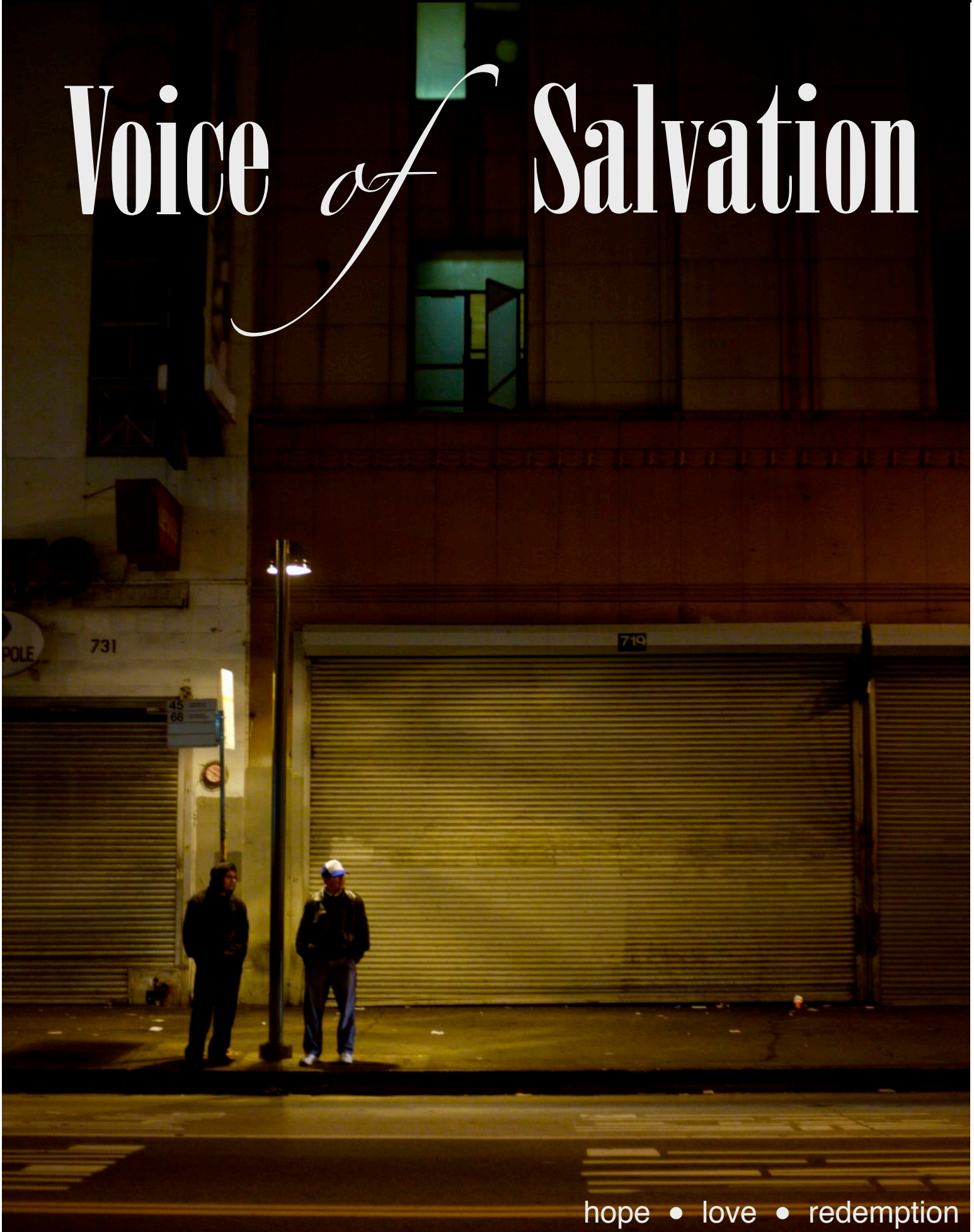

Ben had been doing well, but had started messing around with cocaine again and his family was sick of it. I met with Ben and in despair he told me he felt like he had no hope left. He was tired of fighting addictions, he was tired of losing jobs, he was tired of his life being in shambles.

The Gospel Center is in the middle of hundreds of people who have grown despondent, and have no hope. Children who have been abused; teens who are looking for love and affirmation; people who are addicted; single parents who are ready to crack.

But many are also ready for something different. They are determined that they aren't just going to be another statistic.

basis. The needs are so many that it can be a little overwhelming at times.
