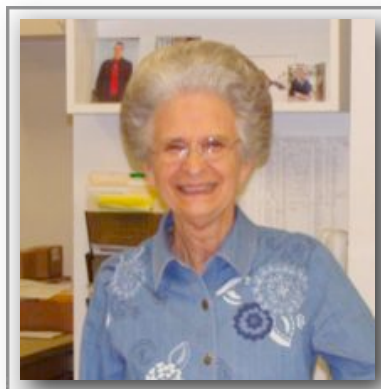
Some of the components of the Redemption Project will include:

how you can help with the redemption project.

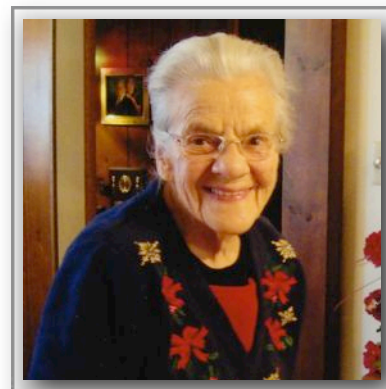
- Pray. We need individuals and families to pray for the all of the ministries of the Gospel Center, and specifically that the Redemption Project will go according to God's will.

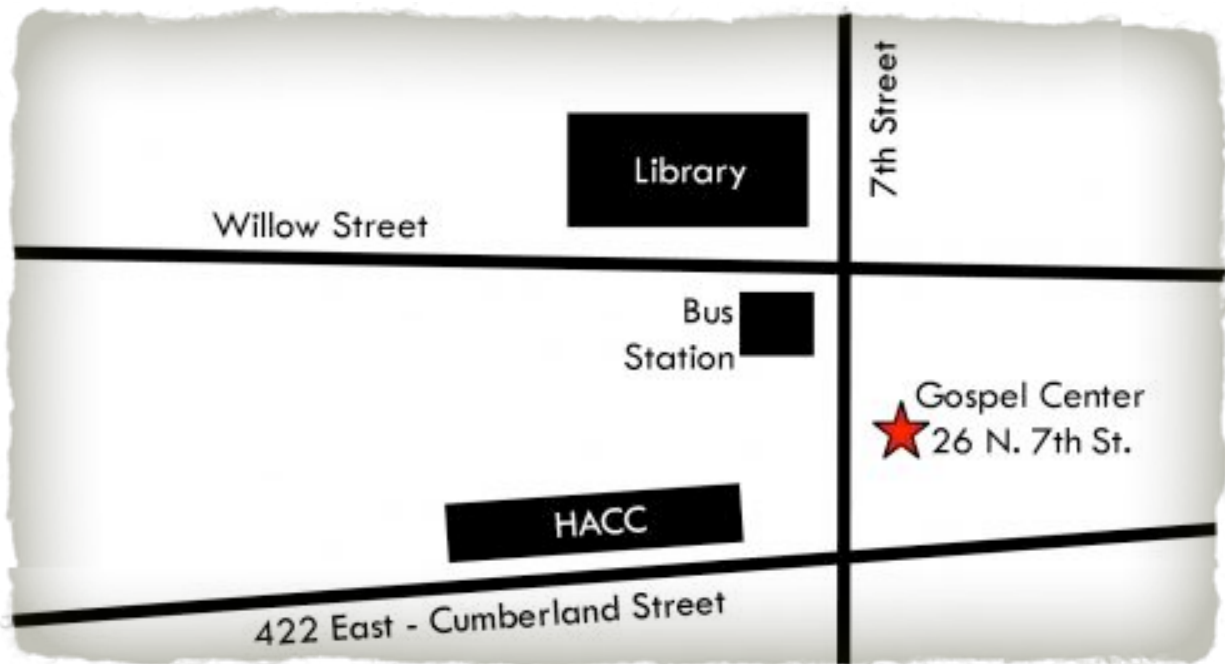
